

VILLANOVA TRAFFIC & CONSTRUCTION UPDATE
Pedestrian Bridge Update

As you know, we are still experiencing construction delays on the Villanova Campus at the Villanova Church. At this time, there is no vehicle traffic through the Spring Mill Road/Route 320 Entrance to Villanova. The roadway behind the Monastery and Church will be blocked for utility construction and the start of Phase IV of the Transformation of the Campus Landscape initiative. As always, be respectful of spaces near the Monastery reserved for the friars who live there.

If you don't have any special mobility needs, **the preferred option continues to be that you park across the street from the Church.** When you come off of Lancaster Avenue at St. Thomas Way, go to the top, turn right, and head to the spaces behind Moriarty Hall or beyond (designated as L-2 parking.) Please be sure to use the crosswalk and follow the pedestrian signals at the St. Thomas Way intersection. This is the only safe way to cross Lancaster Avenue in that vicinity. Please follow the posted signs for pedestrian traffic. The Pedestrian Bridge construction will last through the rest of the year, with completion perhaps by Easter.

Wedding parking update. We have been having the bridal party and handicapped/elderly guests enter at the Fedigan Gate.

Bridal party vehicles pull up to the monastery side of the church (not in the circle); guests needing the ramp drive in front of the church to St. Rita Circle.

Large buses park in the CEER/S2 lot.

No one should be using the Ithan entrance as work will begin on the pavers at the intersection of Mendel, monastery, Alumni, St. Rita's
