Requirements and Qualifications:

In addition, teachers must enjoy working with children and have a great amount of patience, flexibility, outstanding communication, interpersonal and leadership skills.

2. A bachelor's degree including 30 credit hours in early childhood education, child development, special education, elementary education or the human services field and 1 year experience with children
3. Associate's degree in early childhood education, child development, special education, elementary education or the human services field and 2 years of experience with children
4. An Associate's degree including 30 credit hours in early childhood education, child development, special education, elementary education or the human services field and 3 years of experience with children.
