Service Hours FAQ

How many hours of service do I need?

Candidates are expected to perform and record 20 hours of service by their scheduled interview.

How do I record and submit hours?

Record the name of your service, description, signature of an adult, and number of hours on the service form on the confirmation page. When 20 hours are complete email, mail, or deliver to Mrs. Finore on or before the due date. Early submissions are always welcome.

Who needs to sign the service form?

Any adult who is participating at the service event with you or your parents may sign your service form.

Does my service have to be part of an official Church event?

No. Service does not have to be part of an official event. You may also look for opportunities to serve your parents, grandparents, and neighbors (walking dogs, shoveling snow, babysitting, etc.).

If I do service at my school or with my scout troop, will that count?

Yes! Service done for another organization may also be counted for Confirmation. Just be sure to record it on your form.

What about the service I did during the summer?

If you participated in a service event during the summer (after the school year ended), then you may use that service towards Confirmation. For example, students who participated with St. Thomas of Villanova's Stewardship Camp earn service.
