THAT HAD BEEN MORE THAN THEY COULD EAT.
WHEN THE PEOPLE SAW THE SIGN HE HAD DONE, THEY SAID,
“THIS IS TRULY THE PROPHET, THE ONE WHO IS TO COME INTO THE WORLD.”
